IFC Director Positions

Junior IFC (JIFC) Director: The JIFC Director will oversee the implementation of our new program The Junior IFC. The purpose of this organization will be to gather two new members (pledges) from each IFC fraternity and hold bi-weekly meetings that emulate an actual IFC meeting to develop interest and prepare them for a future in The IFC. The new members participating in J-IFC will change each semester, so this director will oversee two different J-IFCs. This director will also develop relationships with campus administrators, as they will host a speaker or activity facilitator at each J-IFC meeting; for example, this could include things such as a leadership workshop with the Center for Leadership and Service or a Campus Life panel with members of SGA. This director will also be in charge of aiding the members of J-IFC in organizing at least one social event and at least one educational and/or philanthropic event each semester.

Philanthropy Director: The Philanthropy Director is responsible for planning and overseeing IFC's major philanthropy and fundraising events throughout the year. Responsibilities include working closely with other members of the Greek community, assisting in promoting various events, planning new events, and keeping track of the existing IFC philanthropy projects like habitat for humanity, the Eric Berry Flag Football Tournament, and several more. This position is also useful in connecting chapters with ideas about how they can help the surrounding community.

Greek Week Director: This Greek Week Director is solely responsible for the activities of Greek Week held each spring. This includes working closely with the other three Greek council's counterpart in the planning of the week's activities. These activities include, but are not limited to: All-Greek sporting events, All-Greek worship, the Habitat build, etc. This position requires the utilization of several other Directors and Exec expertise, as well as delegating tasks throughout the week as there is a large need for Interfraternity Council participation. This position allows free time in the fall to assist with other ongoing IFC projects.

Programming Director: The Programming Director will work closely with the VP of Internal Relations in maintaining and implementing chapter programs and services. They are responsible for overseeing all chapter services, which include but is not limited to scholarship, intramurals, and chaplain programs. Simply put this position is focused on promoting well-rounded men in our organizations. Additionally, they will collaborate with the Philanthropy Director in advocating and planning events.
