



Multicultural Greek Council Membership Standards

Any individual seeking membership into a Multicultural Greek Council-MGC organization must meet said *MGC standards* in order to be considered for membership.

**Each council has their own membership requirements that said individuals must meet to be considered for membership within said MGC organization.

Note: In addition to *MGC standards*, each organization may have additional requirements/qualifications.

Requirements:

- A. **1st Semester 1st Year Students**
 - Must be enrolled FULL TIME UTK Students
- B. **2nd Semester 1st Year/Transfer*/Upper Class Students**
 - 12 Completed UTK Credit hours
 - 2.5 Cumulative G.P.A.

Note: Any student who transferred from Pellissippi State Community College

- C. Be in *good conduct standing* with Student Conduct and Community Standards

Note: Once said candidate is identified as a PNM, any individual who is seeking membership in a MGC organization will automatically be opted into the program if their cumulative is below a 3.0 as a proactive approach to support maintaining or enhancing academic performance. At the point in which the new member semester is completed and they reach the above term and cumulative G.P.A. profile they will be opted out of the program.

Hazing:

The University of Tennessee Knoxville's Office of Sorority of Fraternity Life has a **Zero Tolerance** Policy as it relates to hazing. For more information on UTK's hazing policy please refer to the student handbook *Hilltopics*.

- D. All No alcohol may be present at any designated recruitment/rush event/activity or any event/activity held with the purpose of promoting the organization to or building relationships with perspective members.
- E. There should be no membership activities taking place outside of the fall and spring academic term.
