In order to receive an invitation to the Virtual Formal Rush, the following requirements for membership consideration must be met:

- Have a cumulative and current 2.5 average
- Be a full-time student during the present and prior term
- Must have creditably completed as a full-time student (12+ credit hours) at least one grading period at the institution affiliated with the chapter, immediately preceding submission of application (Fall 2020)

 - Legacy Information and Legacy Application (if applicable)

- Prepare the following documents and submit in the order listed below:
 - Official letter from the college/university registrar that confirms your full-time status as a student
 - Completed Undergraduate Legacy Application (if applicable)
 - Completed Undergraduate Membership Interest Application Form
 - At least one completed Evidence of Community/Campus Involvement (ECCI) Form
 - Two (2) Letters of Reference
 - Letter of Interest in joining Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated®
 - Copy of college/university ID

NOTE: A signature generated with a font is not acceptable. Acceptable methods for signatures include:

- DocuSign
 - Adobe Electronic Signatures
 - Scanned Original Signatures

 - **MUST request e-transcript be sent to the graduate advisor, Katrice W. Jones Morgan at akazdgradadvisor@gmail.com.**
 - UTK's National Pan-Hellenic Council requires "undergraduate students who wish to affiliate with an NPHC organization must meet specific membership qualifications: 1) be enrolled full-time at UTK; 2) 12 UTK Credit Hours Established; and 3) 2.5 Cumulative GPA. *note: GPA and credit hour are the minimum NPHC requirements. Some organization requirements may be higher."
